*Love is Life
Let the eternal
Light of God shine*

God is the source of Love: Thru God we live. It is the light of God that shines. God is Love, Life and Light: Without God, we can do nothing.

From Ezekiel it is known that to look upon God is to know true fear. To look upon God is to perceive true perfection; of the purest-pure/true, perfect white light. A perfect light, without blemish, without radiation (rainbow colors). From the visitation at Fatima, Mother Mary was described as crystal, emanating with a radiant light. During the Transfiguration of Jesus, it was Peter, John and James whom saw God; for their hearts were pure.

In book of Job, true words are spoken: "Behold the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom: and to depart from evil, is understanding." Solomon, the son of David, though wise, did not understand this; for he worshipped idols. The high priests could not see; condemning Jesus to be crucified. The prisoner on the cross, next to Jesus, understood what it means to fear the Lord; and he was saved.

When reading the bible or one of the many visitations, only one precept is needed

- God never deceives
 - No contradictions will exist

An added precept, for God is pure-perfection, itself

- God never wastes His words
- His Words are Love, Life, for He is the Way
 - The picture of perfection

God is triune, the trinity: Consisting of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit

- Yet many, even Catholics, do not believe this simple truth
- God created all; and all is His
 - If a man makes a shelf, he calls it his
 - If a man makes a robot, make something, he calls the product his
 - The moonlight is the light of the sun
- Give yourself, consecrate yourself to Mother Mary and Jesus
 - One cannot become a true master without first being a servant
 - Every great master is first a servant

The bible begins with Genesis, where Adam is born in the likeness of God and Eve is born of the flesh of Adam. It is the flesh that fails the test by Satan: Then/now both know good and evil. Over the years men fall into temptation, causing God to regret making man.

Around 2000[BC], God then makes a covenant with Abraham. When Sara, his wife, hears that she will bear a child she laughs in disbelief; for she was past the time of women.

Around 1500[BC], Moses, while young, kills a man. After waxing old with children, God asks him to take His people out of bondage. Thru the actions that follow, it is clear that Moses is a humble, a just man. Reluctantly he brings the multitudes of Hebrews to Mount Sinai. Those who

do not see, those who cannot hear are joyful, praising a gold calf: Exclaiming “this is our god that took us out of Egypt.”

Around 1000[BC], the Hebrews reject God; saying we want a king, like other peoples. A small boy, David, stands against a giant (about 9[ft]/2.7[m] tall) with a sling and several stones. His faith in God was/is great. The son of David, Solomon, builds a lavish temple to God and he speaks with God twice: He receives much wisdom. Yet Solomon bowed down to idols.

- ❖ The Star of David holds the Holy Cross
 - The scaled-dimensions of which match the Glorious Cross of Dozule

*There are many paths
to an end
only one is perfect*

The Hebrews were not chosen because they were the best, the greatest; they were chosen because they were the weakest among nations. God wants to save as many souls as possible, this is why He chose the Hebrews. Gods’ plan is perfect: This is why God sacrificed His only Son.

Around 500[BC] the Hebrews abandon God for idols and God sends Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, to destroy Jerusalem. The Hebrews are scattered, without a “home.”

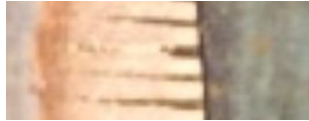
Around October of 4[BC] Elizabeth is visited by an angel. Her husband Zacharias went into the temple of God to perform the holy duty of a select few priests. He was visited by the angel Gabriel and struck mute after he questioned the joyful news. An angel was standing next to him, yet he asked for a sign.

About 500[BC] God destroyed Jerusalem. Near the time of Christ, the ears of the priests were stuffed with wax and their hearts were stiff: Zacharias saw the angel Gabriel and still he questioned God. Then, the High priest and council condemned Jesus; preferring to save a murderer rather than a just man. This is epitomized by Peter cutting-off the ear of a servant; of a chief priest.

Around 1500[AD] Mother Mary visited Guadalupe Mexico: She attained the new title as Our Lady of Guadalupe. Her words were succinct and held life within. The image she left is the Word of God: It took about 500[years] for the catholic church to recognize Our Lady of Guadalupe. Today, many shrug at the image; saying “meh, so-what.” Note that the Tilma cloak/canvas, made from Maguey cactus, should have decayed in 10[y].

- Wearing an off-light-blue colored cloak
 - The color of the “corona” of the sky during the eclipse at the time of her arrival
 - An average RGB color of the sky: Between the full-sky and the eclipse
 - An analysis shows
 - It was painted in “one step,” no sketching
 - The paint is Iridescence, cannot be produced with human hands
 - Slightly changing color with angle/perspective
 - No decay in luminosity of the paint
 - The blueish-green color is unique

- The cloak has 46 stars
 - From Daniel, the 46th day prior to the second coming of Christ, is noted
 - Arch Angel Michael will denote “a time never seen...”
 - The great tribulation
 - Huge hail (Job, Revelation)
- Her dress has flowering vines
 - New vine/s
 - Black ribbon/s: Aztec meaning is pregnant
 - 6 trapezoidal shapes on the ribbon/s: Aztec meaning is end of a cycle
 - She is looking away: Aztec meaning, not a god
- She is surrounded by golden “rays” of light
 - The rays of light are not consistent with a single point of origin, like a sun
 - The rays of the sun are whitish-yellow
 - The rays depicted are golden
 - The rays are emanating from Mother Mary: They are from God
 - As in the visitation of Fatima
 - The golden paint is unmatched in this world, similar to gold-leaf



- At her feet is a dark crescent moon
 - The crescent moon depicts an eclipse of the sun
 - The Light of God outshines the light of the sun
 - The time of Mother Mary’s arrival is written there-in
 - Late in the 8th hour, of 5-Aug-2548
- An angel is holding her cloak, depicting the sky, and her dress, depicting the new vine/s
 - Holding heaven and earth
 - As in a royal procession, in a wedding
 - One holds the dress of the Lady
 - The wedding is of (new) Jerusalem and Jesus
 - The apostles will be at the location
 - As it is written, they will see Jesus come, as they saw Him leave
 - Jesus will arrive after and thru Our Loving Mother
 - As the Christ arrived the first time
 - The thoughts of God are beyond the comprehension of man
 - Pride is of those whom try to comprehend “how” God is Triune
 - Likely the 9th hour of 5-Aug-2548

Around 1670, Jesus appeared to the nun Margaret Mary Alacoque, in France: Requesting the Sacred Heart be placed on the shield of the king of France. The nun in charge, did not believe until Margaret became extremely ill; then, Margaret suddenly recovered.

In 1917, Mother Mary visited three children in Fatima, Portugal. She asked the people of the earth for reparations, prayer and sacrifices to avoid war. Pope Pius XI did not listen; until it was too late.

In 1972, Jesus visited Dozule, France. Jesus asked for the construction of the Glorious Cross. The priest and bishop did not believe; Mrs. Madeleine Aumont. The priest went so far as to ignore an

instruction from Jesus, “do not leave....” The prayer from Dozule has been approved by the Catholic church: The instructions and prophecies by Jesus have been ignored.

- Madeleine did not speak or understand Latin, the priest did
- The prayer of the Glorious Cross is beautiful and full of life
- As Abraham built the alter between east and west
 - The arms of the cross-stretch east to west
- The miracles that occurred continue to be dismissed
 - Vision/s of the Glorious Cross
 - The prayer of the Glorious Cross
 - Graces given
 - Holy ground, blessed by God; same as Conyers, GA
 - Water where there should be none
 - Speaking in an unknown tongue
 - World-wide drought began in late 1999; which continues into 2023
 - Those who do not “feel” the drought say, “there is no drought”
- Numbers are important throughout the bible and the visitations
 - Recall, the 12 baskets of fragments/food and the 7 baskets of fragments/food
 - Recall, as in Daniel, “... time, and times, and half a time”
 - The utilization of gematria links biblical names, times and such
 - There is meaning within the “number”
 - Latin bible
 - The meaning of the number itself, most used reference
 - The Psalm
 - Hebrew bible
 - The meaning of the number itself, most used reference
 - The relation of the numbers is remarkable
 - The relation of the Psalms is remarkable

In the 1990’s, Mother Mary mimicked her requests from Fatima; and gained the title of “Our Loving Mother” at Conyers, GA. The priest of Nancy Fowler believed; yet the visitation was put aside.

Time after time, those given authority love the lamentations of man, more than the Love of God. From the crusades, to Our Lady of Guadalupe, to the Sacred Heart, to Our Lady of Fatima, to Our Lord requesting the Glorious Cross, to Our Loving Mother: In each instance, those in charge dismissed the prophet; wanting another/~~another~~/another “sign.” The necks of many religious have become stiff, as in the days of the crucifixion of Jesus.

- ❖ *Zacharias heard the word of God directly from an angel*
 - *Compare this to Joseph and his dream; not to send Mary away*
 - *How does the man see and the priest cannot?*
- ❖ *The council of priests condemned Jesus*
 - *The raising Lazarus from the dead*
 - *Jesus was threatening their power/hold on the people*
 - *John the Baptist was killed and there was no insurrection*
 - *To maintain their hold on the people: “tis better that one die...”*
 - *Ignoring the healed ear, cut-off in the garden*
 - *They literally chose evil (Barabbas) over good as Pilate washed his hands of the matter*

- ❖ *What does a priest/apostle say to God after ignoring His Word?*
 - *Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life*
 - *Ignore the Word of God and abandoned love, discard life*
 - *The warnings of Fatima were true and spoke of love and life*
 - *What did Pope Pius XI say to God?*
 - *For many died during WWII*
 - *Pope John Paul II, after being shot*
 - *Recognized Our Lady of Fatima*
 - *Recognized Our Lady of Guadalupe*
 - *Saint George, 3rd Century*
 - *Tortured for about a month, to renounce God*
 - *He would not lie and was finally be-headed*
 - *José Sánchez del Río, 1928 Mexican boy saint, 14 years old*
 - *His own grandfather condemned him*
 - *His feet were filleted: The skin of his feet was cut-off*
 - *He would not lie*
 - *If he said no to the chat of “¡Viva Cristo Rey!” he would live*
 - *Never seeing a vision, angel or God, he remained strong*
 - *Praying for God to give him strength*
 - *The wretchedness of a lie takes light away from the heart*
- ❖ *God knows each hair on each head, like each blade of grass on the earth*
 - *How will it endure*
 - *Where it will lay*
 - *When it will bend*
 - *Why it is and why is it*

In these days, Satan is creating a culture that is “all inclusive.” The more the world mimics him, the further from God they fall. Satan will endeavor to divide, to create an open religion; one for all. Jesus will be pushed aside. There is a religious cult called Scientology, whom say that aliens are responsible for our salvation. After 2062, the disintegration of the Catholic church will likely continue at an accelerated rate: For it was the lack of faith that created “the bank of the Vatican” (Institute for the Works of Religion). As communism spreads, freedom suffers; and those in charge will become as the Scribes and the Pharisees at the crucifixion of Jesus. Today, it is said, “it is kind, ‘loving,’ to be inclusive:” Even if it is an abomination to God.

- The devil knows your every weakness
 - **“He knows you from your behavior and your speech.”** (Jesus: From Conyers, GA)
- The devil can invade your dreams, your life
 - He will not give-up, for he knows his time is short
- As the apostles slept in the garden
 - So too Satan puts the hearts of man to sleep
 - For he knows the power of prayer
 - Freedom in perdition is nonexistent
 - **“The truth shall set you free”**

Thru prayer, fasting and love, Satan can be defeated: For without God, none can withstand Satan. It is said that Mother Mary walked the Passion every Friday, for some 15 years: Praying, morning for her Son. Persevere, endeavor to win the victory over Satan by staying close to God: Let His light shine within your tabernacle/castle. Let the light of God radiate outward; to each of your neighbors.

Imagine a crystal, a pure heart, gleaming with a wonderous light. Now, inject a hot-vile blob of acidic gunk into it and watch how it distorts the soul. Anger, hate, lust (among others) the “me, me” attitude distort the heart. Anger is like a drop of ink in a glass of water; it disfigures the soul: Allowing Satan easy access to your heart. The sacrament of confession will clean/repair the soul of a repentant heart.

(Side story) A man whispered to his friend, “he is evil.” He expounds on his knowledge of the matter and wishes to convince his friend that, “that dude is evil.” Unable to recognize that his anger is disfiguring his heart, he continues to be a judge; forgetting the Beatitudes, forgetting the Sermon on the Mount. Many say they follow the Beatitudes; few do. *Remove the beam in thine own eye: Pray, do not judge.*

If a man strikes another, he has darkened his heart. If the injured man turns to offer the other cheek, the Lord will surely do more to the assailant than a man ever could; if not forgiven. When Judas, the betrayer, left the dinner Jesus said, “**Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in him.**” It was in the heart of Judas to betray Jesus, so the sin had already been committed.

(Follow closely)

In 1 John, it is written, “... three who give testimony in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost. And these three are one. And there are three that give testimony on earth: the spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three are one.”

John also writes that the first miracle of Jesus was to turn water into wine; and His second miracle was to give life/heal a child. From Revelation it is written, to “the church of Laodicea” that Jesus, God, is the Amen (it is/truly → I Am/Truth), that Jesus is the Alpha and the Omega. Jesus, God, is like a circle; without beginning and without end.

At the last supper it is written that the last miracle Jesus preformed was to turn wine into His blood. Since the beginning is the end, the blood is His life-giving water, the well that springs forth from the soul; from the Divine Mercy. The second, to the last, miracle was to turn bread into His body; which gives life. God, Himself, said that the life is within the blood (Leviticus 17), thus, the body is His blood; the blood of the Divine Mercy.

Tis true, in the physical world many will taste bread and wine

- As one grows closer to God, the wine loses its flavor
 - It is a grace to taste water of the blood
- As one grows closer to God, the bread tastes as life; the true mana from heaven
 - It is a grace to taste blood of the bread
- Take the body and blood together and the tongue tingles

- ❖ Receive the water of life, the perfectly pure water, and never thirst
 - Let the fountain of life be as rivers of the vine
 - Like the river of Jordan at the baptism of Jesus
- ❖ Receive the blood of life, the perfectly true flesh, and never hunger
 - Invite God into your sanctified castle/tabernacle
 - Like the Holy Spirit at the baptism of Jesus

(The Alpha, the Omega: The end, the beginning)

As in John, one without charity is nothing: Ignore not your neighbor, ignore not the needy.

- It takes love to give of oneself; it need not be money
- “Charity never falleth away ...” (1 Corinthians 13:8)

Just prior to Elijah (Elias) being taken into heaven with chariots of fire, Eliseus asked for double his spirit; and it was granted. Sometime later, Jesus commented that John the Baptist, Elias, was the most powerful prophet in heaven.

- How can this be, because Eliseus had twice the spirit (faith)?
 - God controls the love He gives: It is thru faith and love we grow
 - One can have 10 mustard seeds of faith; without charity there is no love
 - Charity opens the heart to love
 - Faith is stronger than the eye/ear: Zacharias had little faith
 - Love strengthens the friendship of/to God

Vision of the Golden Sacred Heart of Jesus:

Our Lord is in immense agony In an unfathomable, torturous pain

{(Imagine a pure-of-the-purest golden sacred heart with a perfectly-pure golden cross in the midst of zillions of white laser-like filaments being emitted from a single source: The heart is longer (about 20-30%) than the typical Sacred Heart and realistic in form/shape). (The light is perfectly-pure). A snowflake by itself is clear; and when piled-up the color becomes white. God is perfectly clean, clear, translucent; without blemish.}

Picture, if you will, a golden heart: Pure gold, of the purest gold. Above the heart is a golden cross, of the purest gold, gleaming with perfection: Set in the midst of countless rays of pure light. Positioned similar to the Sacred Heart, the heart/cross combination is situated at the center of light; with the purest, most perfect white light. This perfect light is radiating outward; beneath the cross, just above the heart.

In place of the thorns, over ~66% of the golden heart (about 80% of the mass), there are hot volcanic fissures crisscrossing the heart; red, yellow/orange and black in color. Between the fissures there is a seething sea of dark-green gunk. The acidic, corrosive sludge maintains a steady boil; engulfing the Heart ever so slowly.

God absorbs the sins of man, causing His heart great pain; an overwhelming agony. If a soul repents, that “gunk” is removed and the heart is healed: Prayer relieves the Sacred Heart.

- ❖ *Jesus was crowned with thorns by the mocking of man*
 - *Jesus accepted the crown of thorns with Love*
- ❖ *Jesus was whipped with sins tearing at His flesh*

- *Man, Priests/apostles diverting from The Way*
- *Jesus persevered thru the pain by His great Love for us*
- ❖ *Jesus took-up His cross with Love while man placed their burden/s of hate upon Him*
 - *Carry your cross with love, for it is an honor to serve God*
 - *It is an honor to carry your cross*
 - *Jesus Died for us*

I, Daniel, have seen the Golden Sacred Heart of Jesus: Tears immediately came to my eyes, I began to cry. This happened in the chapel where Jesus was exposed; for the Eucharistic Adoration. A couple of times during the Adoration of Jesus, the burden I felt was so profoundly heavy that I would have fainted, if I did not pause from prayer and to take some anxious breaths.

Ask for graces: The closer to God, the greater the peace, the joy of life

- To discern good and evil: Many do not call a sin, a sin
- To discern which path to take; listen to the heart
- When good fortune strikes, it is a blessing from God; not “luck”
- You are free to choose which path you take
 - God will not intercede on your free choice
- **“Ask for the grace to be given the strength and wisdom to have the virtue of patience everyday”**(Jesus: During the visitation/s of Our Loving Mother in Conyers, GA)

Our Loving Mother was born without original sin:

- ❖ She was given a grace by God to be born not knowing good and evil
- ❖ She knows what hurts her Son, by this she knows evil
 - One must be approved by Our Loving Mother, as-in the first miracle (water into wine)
- ❖ She knows honor and truth, for these dwell within the heart of a child

John 4:48 “Unless you see signs and wonders, you believe not”
Matthew 12:38 “... An evil and adulterous generation seeketh a sign”
For we have forgotten the sufferings of Jesus
Jesus died for each of us

Be not a doubting Thomas
Be not a dark lamb
For faith is stronger than the eye
For faith is stronger than the mind
Be not the fool, conjuring-up your mind’s eye
“Look not with your intellect but in the depths of your heart”

Peter, with his heart, defended Jesus in the garden
 The kiss of Judas was thought-out
 Peter, with his mind, renounced Jesus three times
For the haughtiness of man is great

Comments:

When looking into the night sky, space has a light sheen to it; it glistens within “nothingness.” It can be likened to a wet piece of newly milled slate; for a chalkboard. Even in space there is light; thus, space itself gleams with life.

When a chalkboard is used by this world it becomes dull; a dark-grayish color with dull-whitish streaks. As knowledge is poured into the mind, the voice of the heart deadens; faith in God is lost. This world no longer sees the 7 deadly sins as evil; or “worthy of condemnation.” Vices of this world muffle the voice of the heart; the true life within the heart.

Charity can be as simple as a smile to someone who is down: Nourishing love.
Humility can be as simple as a man not wiping away his tear: Nourishing respect.
Patience can be as simple as listening to a friend prattling on ... and on: Nourishing perseverance.

It is easy to take the wide path, to think all on the chalkboard is true. It is hard to follow the narrow path; the stairway to heaven. It is easy to go down the stairs; believing $1+1+1=3$.

It is easier to fight back, rather than turn the other cheek: How much greater will the retribution of God be if the offender is not forgiven?

It is easy to see why a bank benefits an institution: The Catholic Church has a bank, a house of “money changers.” Even within the ranks of the priests/bishops there is a lack of faith.

Ask one with a lack of faith their thoughts on Job 28:28, “... Behold the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom: and to depart from evil, is understanding.” Unable to comprehend the true meaning of the term “fear,” they will be befuddled: And “thinking,” they will say to themselves, “I am far from evil.” Thus, they will disregard what they do not understand.

Ask one of science, how is a snowball white; no substantive answer will be given. Science does not know why, they “think it is because” As in Job, God knows darkness and how it is made and God is the Light.

Ask one of science to explain the eye-witness accounts throughout the bible.

-The “Dead Sea Scrolls” were written years before Jesus

---The Isaiah Scroll is 1000 years older than the oldest Hebrew manuscripts

-----It is complete

-----It matches current translations

Ask one of science to explain the statements of demon’s “... I know who you are ...”

Ask one with a lack of faith to explain the sin of Saint Peter; as Jesus asked him “... do you love me?”

God will not force anyone to walk up the stairway to heaven, for everyone must earn their stripes. Our Loving Mother earned her seat; for who can love more than a mother. God will forgive sins and wash the chalkboard clean; for “The Way” is **earned**.

Two regrets:

- 1) In the dream of “The Soul” (in “Decryption of Revelation”), there-in is a GREAT LOVE
 - a. ***I am so sorry/heartbroken that I cannot describe the Love***
 - i. The development of a soul made known: Love is Life
 1. Nothing is more precious than the newborn soul
- 2) In the vision of The Golden Sacred Heart, Jesus was/is in extreme/severe agony
 - a. ***I am so sorry/heartbroken that I cannot describe the Pain***
 - i. The agony was/is very real
 1. More severe than hot acid on torn flesh

The dream of “The Soul,” the perfectly-pure-Heart and its golden cross are alive and surrounded by Love and Life! The awesomeness of the Love is indescribable. **God Loves everyone with this perfectly-sublime Love:** The dream showed the meaning of Love is Life.

- In the dream of “The Soul,” it was a feeling of a soul that was hungry for knowledge, one that was empty; it was a blank slate. A pure and naïve child, wanting to know “what’s going on.” It was as a dry sponge, soaking-up water as fast as possible (no patience). Once the sponge is well watered, it is difficult to “change the water.”
 - All those whom interact with the soul are responsible for how clean or dirty the water becomes
- Everyone will be held accountable for every thought, every word, every action
 - Treat others as yourself
 - The blood of abortion/murder requires recompense: God may bless the coupling
 - Clinics, pill/s, condoms ... all will be held to account
 - Deadly sins of pride (ego) and wrath (impatience)
 - Sins are no longer recognized

Love as when a mother speaks fondly of her child: In her eyes, one can see that her love is true. No human love compares to that of a mother and her child. This is the life that dies in an abortion.

The love of God is perfect and true. The abandonment of God is also true. Fueled by abortions and “gods” of this world, people “think” too much: They wish to be served, not to serve.

The biblical story of Job has many lessons that go unseen. The first is of wisdom, the second is of eschewing evil and, perhaps the utmost, is pride. Throughout Job, respect and/or the lack of it is prevalent. This simple story offers a foundation to build upon; to grow closer to God. Those whom have a speckled/dark heart will not be able to discern its meaning: The meaning of the Exodus, or the story of Job, will escape them. In one of the parables of Jesus, the master filled his house with the poor/needful for the “rich” had better things to do: There is little difference between the “rich” and priests/bishops that display pride and/or impatience. Patience and charity are keys, to joy and happiness: They open the heart to love.

The story of Samson shows that those who nag do not hold love or respect. Respect contains honor, humility and above all patience. Love of the heart is sublime, for there-in will a husband serve his wife and a wife serve her husband (1 Peter 3 and 1 Corinthians 11): And the children serve their parents. Children with respect will gladly serve.

The solution... pray, then pray some more and ask God for graces: The devil will make thine eyes heavy, so that sleep is preferred. Endure the tests: The joy/happiness will grow.

Love is the key: Grow in love with the sweet fragrance of Charity

Consider Our Loving Mother:

- She grew closer to Jesus with every blade that pierced her heart
 - The prophecy of Simeon: She held the news in her heart
 - On the way back
 - Matthew 2:22, Joseph was afraid to go to Judea
